BUFFALO COUNTY BOARD OF EQUALIZATION
TUESDAY, JUNE 24, 2014
9:00 A.M**

The Buffalo County Board of Supervisors and the Buffalo County Board of Equalization met on Tuesday, June 24, 2014 at 9:00 A.M. and 10:15 A.M. Chairman McMullen called the meeting to order and led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance. The following Board members responded to roll call: Francis Biehl, Joseph Brayton, Kent Greder, Ivan Klein, Sherry Morrow, Dennis Reiter and William McMullen. A copy of the acknowledgment and receipt of notice and agenda by the Board of Supervisors is attached to these minutes. Chairman McMullen announced that in accordance with Section 84-1412 of the Nebraska Revised Statutes, a current copy of the Open Meetings Act is available for review. County Clerk Janice Giffin took all proceedings hereinafter shown; while the convened meeting was open to the public. County Attorney Shawn Eatherton was present.

REGULAR AGENDA

Moved by Brayton and seconded by Reiter to approve the June 10, 2014 Board meeting minutes. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Brayton, Reiter, Biehl, Greder, Klein, Morrow and McMullen. None voted "Nay". Motion declared carried.

Moved by Klein and seconded by Morrow to accept the May 2014 Community Action Partnerships of Mid-Nebraska R.Y.D.E. report. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Klein, Morrow, Biehl, Brayton, Greder, Reiter and McMullen. None voted "Nay". Motion declared carried.

Project Manager Steve Gaasch from Beckenhauer Construction was present to update the Board on the Phases 4-7 Courthouse Renovation Project. No formal action was required.

RESOLUTION 2014-30

WHEREAS, two Buffalo County departments have exceeded their approved budget for the 2013-2014 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, funds are needed to balance the budget for Buffalo County for the fiscal year 2013-2014 at the close of said fiscal year on June 30, 2014

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BUFFALO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, to balance the budget for Buffalo County for the fiscal year 2013-2014 that \$40,000.00 be transferred to the County Court budget and \$44,000.00 be transferred to the Building and Grounds budget with the transfer to be made from the General Miscellaneous budget.

Moved by Klein and seconded by Biehl to approve the following Resolution 2014-31 to set a public hearing date to amend the Adult Entertainment Establishment Ordinance. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Klein, Biehl, Brayton, Greder, Morrow, Reiter and McMullen. None voted "Nay". Motion declared carried.

RESOLUTION 2014-31

WHEREAS, Buffalo County previously adopted an Adult Entertainment Establishment Ordinance, all as set forth in Resolution #2014-006; and

WHEREAS, Buffalo County, acting through its' Board of Supervisors, desires to amend provisions relating to applicability of this ordinance;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Buffalo County Board of Supervisors sets down July 22, 2014, at 11:00 o'clock, a.m. as the date and time of public hearing regarding the following proposed ordinance, with hearing to be conducted in the Buffalo County Boardroom, Buffalo County Courthouse, 16th & Central, Kearney, Nebraska for the following ordinance:

"Be it ordained by the county board of the County of Buffalo, State of Nebraska that Buffalo County's Adult Entertainment Establishment Ordinance, all as set forth in Resolution #2014- 006 as concerns "Section F. Applicability" be amended as authorized pursuant to Neb.Rev.Stat. §23-174.10 and § 23-187, *et seq* to read as follows:

"SECTION F. APPLICABILITY:

This ordinance shall be effective within the boundaries of Buffalo County, Nebraska, except those areas inside of the corporate boundaries of any city or village or outside the corporate boundaries of any city or village in which such city or village is exercising powers by ordinance on a similar subject matter to which this ordinance pertains. ~~The definition of Adult Entertainment Establishment and the provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to the opening or commencement of a new business, the conversion of an existing business to an Adult Entertainment Establishment, the addition to or expansion of an existing Adult Entertainment Establishment, or the relocation of any Adult Entertainment Establishment.~~ An existing Adult Entertainment Establishment now in existence at time of adoption of this ordinance that violates any distancing requirement of this ordinance shall be allowed to continue to exist but shall not be allowed to expand its business. If an existing Adult Entertainment Establishment now in existence ceases to be operational for any span of one hundred eighty (180) days, it shall not be allowed to reopen and any future use of the building, property, and premises shall conform to this ordinance."

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT a copy of this amending resolution be published for two consecutive weeks, with the last publication not less than five (5) days nor more than two weeks prior to the first public hearing, with copy of this proposed ordinance amendment sent to all Village and City Clerks of Buffalo County no later than seven (7) days after the first reading of this proposed ordinance.

Moved by Klein and seconded by Biehl to recess the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors at 10:05 A.M. and reconvene as a Board of Equalization. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Klein, Biehl, Brayton, Greder, Morrow, Reiter and McMullen. None voted "Nay". Motion declared carried.

BOARD OF EQUALIZATION

Chairman McMullen called the Board of Equalization to order in open session. County Treasurer Jean Sidwell, County Assessor Joe Barber, Deputy County Assessor Nora Borer, Gwen Campbell, Scott Anderson, Laura Fredericks and Russell Schukar were present.

Rebecca Becker was present to discuss a waiver of the statute time limits so that the County Assessor may review the application for exemption of paying personal property tax for the Todd Becker Foundation. Moved by Klein and seconded by Greder to waive the statute time limits to review permissive exemption request from the Todd Becker Foundation. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Klein, Greder, Biehl, Brayton, Morrow, Reiter and McMullen. None voted "Nay". Motion declared carried.

Chairman McMullen opened the Public hearing for consideration of the 2014 tax year exemption request for the Todd Becker Foundation at 10:09 A.M. Moved by Greder and seconded by Reiter to approve Motor Vehicle Tax Exemption as indicated on the application by County Treasurer Sidwell for South Central Behavioral Services, Inc. on a 2005 Chevrolet Van, two 2006 Chrysler Minivans, three 2007 Toyota Camrys, 2007 Ford Taurus and a 2009 Toyota Camry. Moved by Morrow and seconded by Biehl to approve Motor Vehicle Tax Exemption as indicated on the application by County Treasurer Sidwell for Kearney Catholic High School on a 2008 Chevrolet Suburban, 2009 Chevrolet Suburban and a 2011 Chevrolet

Suburban. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted “Aye”: Morrow, Biehl, Brayton, Greder, Klein, Reiter and McMullen. None voted “Nay”. Motion declared carried.

Moved by Klein and seconded by Greder to approve Motor Vehicle Tax Exemption as indicated on the application by County Treasurer Sidwell for Mother Hull Home on a 2005 Chevrolet Van. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted “Aye”: Klein, Greder, Biehl, Brayton, Morrow, Reiter and McMullen. None voted “Nay”. Motion declared carried.

Moved by Biehl and seconded by Morrow to approve Motor Vehicle Tax Exemption as indicated on the application by County Treasurer Sidwell for Benedictine Sisters on a 2007 Pontiac Grand Prix.
