1. Re-instalación de una licencia que ha sido suspendida o revocada.
2. Reducción de dos puntos por la historia de manejar, si tiene derecho.
3. Solicitud de permiso para manejar al empleo.
4. Ordenada por la Corte o la libertad condicional.

ADD le dará la información sobre los requisitos para una licencia de Nebraska para manejar, según explica el Manual de Choferes de Nebraska.


This 8-hour course will satisfy the requirements for:

1. Reinstatement of revoked/suspended license.
2. Two-point credit on personal driving record for those who are eligible.
3. Application of employment driving permit.
4. Court/probation order.

ADD is focused on the following categories of violators:

1. Repeat Traffic Violators whose point losses could result in loss of their license and productivity.
2. Suspended/Revoked Drivers.
3. First-Time Violators that exhibit poor decision making and/or behaviors.
4. First-Time DWI/DUI. This opportunity could just turn their thinking around so there isn't a second time.
5. Minor-In-Possession.
6. DUS (Driving Under Suspension).

ADD is believable—It demonstrates the power of CHOICES...It defines the limits of RESPONSIBILITY...It carefully outlines the difference between proactive and reactive DECISION-MAKING...It focuses on how important a personal value system is when something/someone evokes an ATTITUDE from us and what BEHAVIOR will be chosen—It outlines the elements of ANGER CONTROL—It provides an informational format involving ALCOHOL. It challenges with the question, "HAS MY BEHAVIOR BEEN GETTING ME WHAT I WANT?"
