Applications 1507. } Whereas, There has been

deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the Public Domain," and the act supplemental thereto, the claim of Wesley F. Harsch has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the North East quarter of Section Four, in Township Eight North, of Range Sixteen West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Grand Island, Nebraska, containing one hundred and fifty six acres, and sixteen hundredths of an acre, according to the official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General: Now know ye, that there is, therefore, granted by the United States unto the said Wesley F. Harsch the tract of Land above described: To have and to hold the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances ~~the tract of Land above described: To have and to hold the said tract of Land thereof,~~ unto the said Wesley F. Harsch and to his heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof, I, Ulysses S. Grant, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
