WHEREAS, Robert A. McCool of Buffalo County, Nebraska has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office (of the Land Office) at Grand Island, Nebraska, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Robert A. McCool according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," and the acts supplemental thereto, for the North half of the North East quarter of Section ten in Township eleven North of Range fifteen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing eighty acres according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Robert A.
