McKeon deceased* has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the *North East Quarter of the North West Quarter, the North half of the North East Quarter and the South East Quarter of the North East Quarter of Section Thirty six Township Twelve North of Range Eighteen West of the Fifth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and fifty acres* according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:
