To all whom these presents may come greeting:

Certificate, Number 1133. Whereas Joseph McKain of Buffalo County, Nebraska, has deposited in the general land office of the United States, a certificate <sup>legitimate</sup> of the land office at Grand Island, Nebraska, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Joseph McKain according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24<sup>th</sup> of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" and the acts supplemental thereto, for the lots numbered three and four of section eleven in township eight north, of range fifteen west, in the district of lands subject to sale at Grand Island, Nebraska, containing one hundred and five acres and thirty hundredths of an acre according to the Official Plat of the survey of said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased by the said Joseph McKain. Now, knowye, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Joseph McKain and to his heirs, the said tract above described; To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, ~~privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, and to his heirs the said tract above described;~~ <sup>privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature,</sup> and therunto belonging, unto the said Joseph McKain and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, Rutherford B. Hayes, President of the United States of America, have caused this letter to be made patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington, the twenty first day of July, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy nine, and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and fourth.
