Whereas There has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States a Certificate of the REGISTER of the LAND OFFICE

of Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Acts of Congress approved March 3, 1873, March 13, 1874, and June 14, 1878,

"To encourage the Growth of Timber on the Western Prairies," the claim of Albert Moore

has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the

North part quarter of Section Twenty Six in Township Four North Range West of the Fifth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and sixty acres

according to the ORIGINAL Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVYOR GENERAL:

You know me. That there is, therefore, granted by the United States unto the said Albert Moore

the tract of Land above described: To have and to hold the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances

thereof unto the said Albert Moore and to his

heirs and assigns forever.


