

Timber Culture Certificate No. 2. Application 53

The United States of America to all to whom these presents shall come greeting: Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island, Nebraska whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved March 3, 1843. March 13 1874 and June 14, 1878. To encourage the growth of Timber on the "Western Prairies" the claim of Henry W. Morse has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the North West Quarter of Section Four in Township Nine, North of Range Fifteen west of the 6th Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing One Hundred and Sixty Acres according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General Newell H. G. That there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Henry W. Morse the tract of land above described To have and to hold the said tract of land with the appurtenances thereto unto the said Henry W. Morse and to his heirs and assigns forever In testimony whereof I Chester A. Arthur President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington the Tenth day of March in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty Three and of the Independence of the United States the 107th
