To all whom these presents shall come greeting
 Whereas Albert J. Murriah of Buffalo County
 Nebraska has deposited in the General Land
 Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register
 of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska
 whereby it appears that Full Payment has been
 made by the said Albert J. Murriah according
 whereby it appears to the provisions of the act of
 Congress of the 24th of April 1820 entitled an act
 making further provisions for the sale of
 the Public Lands and the acts supplemental
 thereto for lot numbered three of section
 Twenty Five in Township nine north of Range
 fifteen and the lot numbered seven eight nine
 and ten of section thirty in Township nine
 north of Range fourteen west of the Sixth
 Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing
 one hundred and fifty four acres and
 seventy six hundredths of an acre
 according to the official Plat of the Survey
 of the said lands returned to the General
 Land Office by the Surveyor General which
 said tract has been purchased by the said
 Albert J. Murriah now know ye that the
 United States of America in consideration
 of the premium and in conformity with the
 several acts of Congress in such case made
 and provided have given and granted and
 by these Presents do give and grant unto the
 said Albert J. Murriah and to his heirs
 the said tract above described to have
 and to hold the same together with all the
 rights privileges immunities and appurtenances
 of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging unto
 the said Albert J. Murriah and to his heirs
 and assigns forever
