Crable has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law, for the

South half of the North west quarter and the lots numbered three and four of section thirty in Township nine north range fourteen west in the district of Nebraska subject to sale at Grand Island, Nebraska containing one hundred and eighty four acres and eighty eight hundredths of an acre

according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said David P. Crable the tract of land above described, to have and to hold the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said David P. Crable and to his heirs and assigns forever.
