Now know ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by their presents do give and grant, unto the said Roman Fritz and to his heirs, the said Tract above described; To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said Roman Fritz and to his heirs and assigns forever. In Testimony whereof, J. Grover Cleveland, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington, the twenty seventh day of July, in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty five, and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and tenth.
