Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears that pursuant to the Acts of Congress approved March 3. 1873. March 13. 1874 and June 14. 1878 "To encourage the growth of timber on the Western Prairies; the claim of Floyd F. Gargett has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the North East quarter of Section Twenty Eight in Township Ten North of Range Seventeen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and sixty acres according to the official plat of the survey of the said land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General. Now know ye that there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Floyd F. Gargett the tract of land above described. To have and to hold the said tract of land with the appurtenances thereunto the said Floyd F. Gargett and to his heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof I Grover Cleveland President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made patents and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington the twentieth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty eight and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and tenth.
