Geyer to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands", and the acts supplemental thereto, for the

Lots numbered three four and five and the South East quarter of the North West quarter of Section six in Township ten North of Range eighteen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and sixty two acres and seventy five hundredths of an acre,

Geyer and to his heirs, the said Tract above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Andrew T. Geyer and to his heirs and assigns forever.
