Do All to Whom these Presents shall come greeting...

Whereas Byron W. Goulding of Buffalo County Nebraska has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears that Full Payment has been made by the said Byron W. Goulding, according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the public Lands," and the acts supplemental thereto, for the lots numbered three and four of Section Twenty-seven, and the lot numbered three of Section Twenty-eight in Township Nine North of Range Fifteen West in the district of lands subject to sale at Grand Island, Nebraska, containing one hundred and forty eight acres, and fifty six hundredths of an acre, according to the official Plat of the survey of the survey of the lands, returned to the general Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Byron W. Goulding, Now Know ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the promises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such cases made and provided, have given and granted, the said tract above described, to have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Byron W. Goulding, and to his heirs and assigns, forever.

In Testimony whereof, I Rutherford B. Hayes, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand at the City of Washington, the first day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty, and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and fourth.
