has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate
of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska whereby it
appears that full payment has been made by the said William b. Grif-
fith according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April,
1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Pub-
lic Lands," for the South west quarter of section twenty two, in Township
Nine North, of Range sixteen west, in the district of lands subject to
sale at Grand Island Nebraska containing One hundred and sixty
acres according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said lands, re-
turned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said
Tract has been purchased by the said William b. Griffith.

Now, Know ye, that the United States of America, in consid-
eration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Con-
gress in such case made and provided, Have Given and Granted,
and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said William b.
Griffith and to his heirs, the said Tract above described; To have and
To hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities,
and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the
said William b. Griffith and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, Ulysses S. Grant, President
of the United States of America have caused these
letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the Gen-
eral Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
