To all to whom these presents shall come greeting:  
 Whereas George W. Hackett of Buffalo County Nebraska has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said George W. Hackett according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24<sup>th</sup> of April 1820 entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the public lands" and the acts supplemental thereto for the South half of the North East quarter and the South half of the North West quarter of Section 16 sixteen in Township twelve North of Range seven West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and sixty acres according to the official plat of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been purchased by the said George W. Hackett. Now know ye that the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said George W. Hackett and to his heirs the said tract above described to have and to hold the same together with all the rights privileges immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging unto the said George W. Hackett and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony whereof I Benjamin Harrison President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington the second day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety one and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and fifteenth.
