Nalstead according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820 entitled "An Act making further provisions for the sale of the Public Lands" and the acts supplemental thereto, for the North East quarter of the South East quarter of Section Twelve in Township Twelve North of Range Twelve West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing forty acres according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Director General which said tract has been purchased by the said Andrew J. Nalstead.

Nalstead and to his heirs and assigns forever.
