To all to whom these presents shall come Greeting

Whereas Lewis Halstead of Buffalo County Nebraska, has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a Certificate of the Registrar of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska, whereby it appears that Full Payment, has been made by the said Lewis Halstead according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820 entitled "An Act making further provisions for the sale of the Public Lands" and the act supplemental thereto for the North East quarter of the North East quarter of Section Twelve in Township Twelve North of Range Thirteen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing forty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been purchased by the said Lewis Halstead.

Now Know ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such cases made and provided, Have given and granted, and by these presents Do give and grant, unto the said Lewis Halstead and to his heirs, said tract above described, So have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, therunto belonging, unto the said Lewis Halstead and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, D. Grover Cleveland President of the United States of America, has caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
