No. 11 10 } Whereas James A. Harrow of Buffalo County,
Nebraska has deposited in the General Land Office of
the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office
at Grand Island, Nebraska whereby it appears that full
payment has been made by the said James A. Harrow
according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the
24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further pro-
vision for the sale of the Public Lands," and the acts suppl-
emental thereto, for the North West quarter of Section thirty-
five, in Township nine North of range fifteen West,
^{in the District of lands subject to sale at Grand Island Nebraska}
containing one hundred and sixty acres according
to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands,
returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor
General, which said tract has been purchased by
the said James A. Harrow.

Now knowye, that the United States of America in
consideration of the premises, and in conformity with
the several acts of Congress in such case made and
provided, have given and granted, and by these pres-
ents do give and grant, unto the said James A. Harrow
and to his heirs, the said Tract above described; To have
and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges,
immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature
thereunto belonging, unto the said James A. Harrow and
to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, Rutherford B. Hayes, President
of the United States of America, have caused these letters
to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office
to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand at the City of Washington, the
twenty first day of July, in the year of our Lord one thousand
and eight hundred and seventy nine, and of the Inde-
pendence of the United States the one hundred and
