Whereas there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States a CERTIFICATE of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress passed

20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain" and the supplemental thereto, the claim of Isaac Fleuthorn

has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the North half of the South East quarter and the Lots numbered three and four of Section thirty four, in Township nine North of Range fifteen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska, containing one hundred and sixty-one acres and sixty-eight hundredths of an acre.

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE
by the SURVEYOR GENERAL.

Now know ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said
Isaac Hawthorn the tract of Land
above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land with the appurtenances thereto unto
the said Isaac Hawthorn and to his heirs and assigns forever
This patent is issued in lieu of an original one dated March 18th 1871 which has been
cancelled
