To All to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting: Certificate No 1127

Whereas Margaret Heuthorn of Buffalo County Nebraska has deposited in the general Land office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears that full Payment has been made by the said Margaret Heuthorn according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24<sup>th</sup> of April 1820 entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" and the acts supplemental thereto for the lots numbered one and two of section twelve, in Township eight north of Range fifteen west, in the district of lands subject to sale at Grand Island Nebraska containing fifty three acres and ninety hundredths of an acre, according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Margaret Heuthorn. Now know ye, that the United States of America in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Margaret Heuthorn and to her heirs, the said tract above described. To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Margaret Heuthorn her testimony whereof I Rutherford B. Hayes President of The United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand, at the city of Washington the twenty first day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy nine, and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and fourth.
