The United States of America,

To all to whom these presents shall come greeting:

Whereas August Hermann of Buffalo County, Nebraska has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island, Nebraska whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said August Hermann according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of public lands," and the acts amendatory thereto, for the West half of the South East quarter of Section four in Township twelve North, of Range sixteen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska, containing eighty acres, according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said August Hermann. Now knowye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said August Hermann and to his heirs, the said tract above described. To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of what ever nature, therunto belonging unto the said August Hermann and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I Benjamin Harrison, President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand at the city of Washington the thirty first day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and twenty
