North East Quarter of Section two in Township twelve North of Range eighteen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and sixty six acres and eighty four hundredths of an acre

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased by the said Mary P. Hess

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA; in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said Mary P. Hess and to her heirs, the said Tract above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, therunto belonging, unto the said Mary P. Hess and to her heirs and assigns forever.
