Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska, whereby it appears that pursuant to the act of Congress, approved 20th May 1862 "To secure Homesteads to actual Settlers on the Public Domain" and the Act's supplemental thereto, the claim of Michael N. Hildebrand has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the East Half of the North East quarter of section four, in Township nine, of Range Sixteen West, in the District of lands subject to Sale at Grand Island Nebraska containing Seventy Eight acres and Eighty one hundredths of an acre, according to the official Plat of Survey of the said Land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General.

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore, granted by the United States unto the said Michael N. Hildebrand, the tract of land above described: To have and to hold the said tract of land with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Michael N. Hildebrand, and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony whereof I Ulysses S. Grant, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, ^{and the seal of the General Land Office to be thereunto affixed by my} under my hand, at the City of Washington the first day of November, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Seventy five, and of the Independence of the United States the One Hundredth
