To all to whom these presents shall come, Greetings.
Certificate No. 4468.

Whereas, William Hodgson, of Buffalo County of Nebraska, has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island, Nebraska, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said William Hodgson according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands; and the acts supplemental thereto, for the North West quarter of Section Twenty-two in Township Twelve North of Range Thirteen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska, containing One Hundred & Sixty acres, according to the Official Map of the Survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased by the said William Hodgson, Now know ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided, Have given and granted, and by these presents, do give and grant unto the said William Hodgson and to his heirs, the said Tract above described; To have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said William Hodgson and to his heirs and assigns forever.

caused these letters to be made Patent and the seal of the
General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
