 N: 901 } Whereas Bradford J. Holmes of Buffalo
 County, Nebraska has deposited in the General Land Office of
 the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at
 Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears, that full payment
 has been made by the said Bradford J. Holmes according to the
 provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled,
 "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public
 Lands," for the South half of the South West quarter of Section
 thirty two, in township ten North of Range fifteen west, in
 the district of lands subject to sale at Grand Island Neb-
 raska containing Eighty acres, according to the Official Plat
 of the Survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land
 Office by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been
 purchased by the said Bradford J. Holmes Now, know ye,
 That the United States of America, in consideration of the prem-
 ises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in
 such case made and provided, have given and granted, and
 by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Bradford
 J. Holmes and to his heirs, the said Tract above described;
 To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights,
 privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature,
 thereunto belonging, unto the said Bradford J. Holmes and
 to his heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof, I,
 Ulysses S. Grant, President of the United States of America have
 caused these letters to be made patent, and the seal of the
 General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my
 hand, at the City of Washington, the tenth day
 of April, in the year of our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred and seventy five, and of the
 Independence of the United States the ninety ninth.
