

The United States of America.

To all whom these presents shall come. Greeting:  
Certificate No. 3219. Whereas, Joseph M. Huffman, of Buffalo  
County, Nebraska, has deposited in the General Land Office of the  
United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand  
Island, Nebraska, whereby it appears that full payment has been  
made by the said Joseph M. Huffman, according to the provisions  
of the Act of Congress of the 24th. of April 1820, entitled "An Act making  
further provisions for the sale of the Public Lands," and the acts  
supplemental thereto, for the south half of the south west  
quarter of section Fourteen in Township eleven north of Range  
seventeen west of the sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska,  
containing eighty acres, according to the official plat of  
the Survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land  
Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased  
by the said Joseph M. Huffman. Now, know ye, that the United  
States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conform-  
ity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and  
provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant;  
unto the said Joseph M. Huffman and to his heirs, the said tract  
above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the  
rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever  
nature, thereto belonging, unto the said Joseph M.  
Huffman and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony whereof, J. Grover Cleveland, President of the United  
States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the  
Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand, at the City of Washington,  
the third day of September in the year four and one  
thousand eight hundred and eighty seven, and of the  
Independence of the United States the one hundred  
and twelfth.
