

Instrumentary act by J. H. Bartlett & off-

The United States of America, To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting: Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled 'An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain officers and soldiers who have been engaged in the Military service of the United States,' there has been deposited in the General Land Office, Warrant No. 113541 for 160 acres, in favor of Jane Martin widow of William Martin Assistant Commissary Revolutionary War with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the lots numbered seventeen, eighteen, twenty three and twenty four of section six, in Township Nine, North of Range sixteen West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Grand Island Nebraska, containing one hundred and sixty acres according to the official Plat of the survey of the said land returned to the General Land Office by the surveyor General the said warrant having been duly assigned by the said Jane Martin to Joseph R. Hurst, in whose favor said tract has been located Now know ye, that there is, therefore granted by the United States unto the said Joseph R. Hurst as assigned as aforesaid and to his heirs the tract of Land above described: to have and to hold the said tract of Land with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Joseph R. Hurst as assigned as aforesaid and to his heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof, I, Ulysses S. Grant, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand, at the City of Washington the twentieth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy five, and of the Independence of the United States the ninety ninth.
