Certificated } Whereas Alice V. Jenkins of Buffalo County Nebraska
No 4790 }aska has deposited in the General Land Office of the
United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at
Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears that full payment
has been made by the said Alice V. Jenkins according to the
provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820 entitled
"An act making further provision for the sale of the Public
Lands" and the acts supplemental thereto for the lots numbered
Eight and Nine of Section seven and the lots numbered five
and six of Section Eight in Township Eight North of Range
Thirteen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska
containing Seventy One acres and Fifty hundredths of an acre
according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said lands
returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General
which said Tract has been purchased by the said Alice V
Jenkins. Now know ye that the United States of America
in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the
several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided have
given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto
the said Alice V. Jenkins and to her heirs the said Tract above
described: To have and to hold the same together with all the
rights privileges immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever
nature thereunto belonging unto the said Alice V. Jenkins and
to her heirs and assigns forever. In Testimony whereof I,
Benjamin Harrison President of the United States of America
have caused these letters to be made Patent and the seal of the
General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

of February in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight
Hundred and Ninety and of the Independence of the United
States the One Hundred and Fourteenth.
