monso-26. } Whereas John N. Jenkins of Buffalo County,
Nebraska, has deposited in the General Land Office of the
United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office
at Grand Island, Nebraska, whereby it appears that full
payment has been made by the said John N. Jenkins to the pro-
visions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1826, entitled
"An act making further provision for the sale of the Public
Lands;" and the acts supplementary thereto, for the South half
of the North west Quarter of section ten in Township nine North of
range seventh west of the sixth Principal Meridian in
Nebraska, containing eighty acres, according to the official Plat
of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office
by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased
by the said John N. Jenkins, now known as, That the United
States of America in consideration of the premises, and in con-
formity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made
and provided, have given and granted and by these presents
do give and grant unto the said John N. Jenkins and to his heirs,
the said Tract above described, to have and to hold the same, together
with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of what-
soever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said John N. Jenkins
and to his heirs and assigns forever. In Testimony whereof, J. Benja-
min Harrison, President of the United States of America has
caused these letters to be read Patent, and the seal of the
General Land Office to be hereunto affixed, Given under my
hand, at the City of Washington, the twenty ninth day of
October, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and ninety nine, and of the Independence of the United
States the one hundred and fourteenth.
