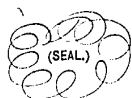

Bassett has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law, for the

North-east quarter of Section six in township nine north of Range thirteen west in the district of lands subject to sale at Grand Island Nebraska containing one hundred and sixty acres

according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Samuel C. Bassett the tract of land above described, to have and to hold the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Samuel C. Bassett and to his heirs and assigns forever.
