Whereas, There has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Lincoln Nebraska, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved March 3, 1873, March 13, 1874 and June 14, 1878, "To encourage the growth of timber on the Western prairie," the claim of

Edmund P. Jones has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the South East quarter of Section Seven in Township Twelve North of Range Eighteen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and sixty acres according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

Now Know Ye, That there is, therefore, granted by the United States unto the said Edmund P. Jones the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Edmund P. Jones and to his heirs and assigns forever.
