William H Jordan
Homestead Certificate No 1506. Application 6175.
The United States of America to all to whom these presents shall come
greeting: Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office
of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand
Island Nebraska whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of
Congress approved 20th May 1862 'To secure Homesteads to actual
Settlers on the Public Domain' and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim
of William H Jordan has been established and duly consummated in
conformity to law for the East half of the South West quarter and the East
half of the North West quarter of Section Eight in Township Eleven North
of Range Sixteen West in the District of Lands subject to sale at
Grand Island Nebraska containing one hundred and sixty acres. ac-
cording to the official plat of the survey of the said land returned to the gen-
eral Land Office by the Surveyor General. Now know ye, that there is,
therefore, granted by the United States unto the said William H Jordan
the tract of land above described: to have and to hold the said tract of
land with the appurtenances thereunto the said William H Jordan
and to his heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof I Rutherford
B Hayes President of the United States of America have caused these let-
ters to be made patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be here-
unto affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington the twenty-
sixth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hun-
dred and seventy seven and of the Independence of the United States the
one hundred and second.
