 Application 6107 } To all to whom these presents shall come greeting:
 Whereas, there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States
 a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island Nebraska,
 whereby it appears, that, pursuant to the act of Congress approved 20th May,
 1862, "To secure homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain", and
 the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Joshua R. King has been es-
 tablished and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the South
 East quarter of Section eight, in Township nine, North of Range sixteen
 West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska, containing one
 hundred and sixty acres according to the official plat of the survey of
 the said land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General.
 Now knowye, that there is, therefore granted by the United States unto
 the said Joshua R. King the tract of land above described: To have and
 to hold the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereto, unto the
 said Joshua R. King and to his heirs and assigns forever.
 In testimony whereof, I, Chester A. Arthur, President of the United States
 of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the
 General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
 Given under my hand, at the city of Washington the Tenth day of October
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty-two
 and of the Independence of the United States the one hundredth seventh.
