 greeting: Certificate }  
 No. 766 } Whereas Isaac D. La Barre of Buffalo Co-  
 untly Nebraska has deposited in the General Land Office of the  
 United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at  
 Grand Island Nebraska whereby it appears that full payment  
 has been made by the said Isaac D. La Barre according to  
 the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24<sup>th</sup> of April, 1820,  
 entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of  
 the Public Lands," for the south half of the south East  
 quarter of section fourteen in Township nine North of  
 Range fourteen West, in the District of Lands subject to  
 sale at Grand Island Nebraska containing eighty acres;  
 according to the official plat of the survey of the said  
 lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Sur-  
 veyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the  
 said Isaac D. La Barre, Now, know ye, That the United  
 States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in  
 conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such cases  
 made and provided, have given and granted, and by  
 these presents do give and grant, unto the said Isaac  
 D. La Barre and to his heirs, the said tract above des-  
 cribed; To have and to hold the same, together with all  
 the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of  
 whatsoever nature, hereunto belonging, unto the said  
 Isaac D. La Barre and to his heirs and assigns for-  
 ever. In testimony whereof, I, Ulysses S. Grant, Presi-  
 dent of the United States of America, have caused these  
 letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General  
 Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my  
 hand, at the city of Washington, the fifth day of Dec-  
 ember, in the year of our Lord, one thous-  
 and eight hundred and seventy four, and  
 of the Independence of the United States the  
 ninety ninth.
