North half of the North East quarter and the North half of the North West quarter of Section eight in Township nine North of Range seventeen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and sixty acres

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchase by the said William C. Lantz

Now Know Ye, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided, Have Given and Granted, and by these presents Do Give and Grant, unto the said William C. Lantz and to his heirs, the said Tract above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said William C. Lantz and to his heirs and assigns forever.
