 Greeting: Homestead Certificate No. 330 }
 Application 3293 } Whereas There has been
 deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate
 of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island, Nebraska, whereby
 it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May
 1862, 'To secure Homesteads to actual Settlers on the Public Domain
 and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Henry F. Leonard
 has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law
 for the South East quarter of Section Twenty eight, in Township
 Nine North, of Range Seventeen West, in the District of Lands
 subject to sale at Grand Island, Nebraska, containing one hund-
 red and sixty acres according to the Official Plat of the survey
 of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the
 Surveyor General: Now know ye, that there is, therefore, grant-
 ed by the United States unto the said Henry F. Leonard the
 tract of Land above described: To have and to hold the said
 tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said
 Henry F. Leonard and to his heirs and assigns forever. In test-
 imony whereof, I, Ulysses S. Grant, President of the United States
 of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and
 the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand, at the city of Washing-
 ton, the thirtieth day of September, in the year of our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred and seventy four, and of the Indep-
 endence of the United States the ninety ninth.
