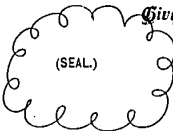

Whereas, there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at *Grand Island, Nebraska* whereby it appears that, pursuant to the act of Congress, approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of *Ashbury Collins* has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law, for the *forty numbered One, Two, Three and Four of Section Twelve in Township Eight North of Range Sixteen West in the District of Lands subject to sale at Grand Island Nebraska containing ninety one acres and six hundredths of an acre.*

according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said *Ashbury Collins* the tract of land above described, to have and to hold the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Ashbury Collins* and to *his* heirs and assigns forever.
