Whereas, there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a CERTIFICATE of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island, Nebraska, whereby it appears that pursuant to the Acts of Congress approved March 3, 1873, March 13, 1874, and June 14, 1878, "to encourage the growth of timber on the Western Prairie," the claim of Harvey Lockhart

has been established and duly commenced in conformity to law for the South East quarter of Section, heretofore eight in Township twelve North, of Range eighteen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and sixty acres

according to the Official Plot of the Survey of the said Land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General.


