The United States of America. To all to whom these Presents shall come Greeting. Whereas In pursuance of the Act of Congress approved July 2, 1862, entitled "An act donating Public Lands to the several States and Territories which may provide for the benefit of Agriculture and the Mechanics Arts" there has been deposited in the General Land Office Scrip No 263, for one quarter section of Land in favor of the State of Virginia, duly assigned by the proper authority of the said State to Daniel McLogan, with evidence that the same has been located upon the North East quarter of Section Twenty four in Township Nine North of Range Sixteen West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Grand Island Nebraska, containing One hundred and sixty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Daniel McLogan as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs the tract of land above described; To Have and to Hold the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Daniel McLogan as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony whereof I Ulysses S. Grant President of the United States of America, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand at the City of Washington the first day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy three and of the Independence of the United States the ninety seventh
