Whereas, There has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island, Nebraska, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress March 3, 1873, March 13, 1874, June 14, 1878, To Encourage the Growth of Timber on the Western Prairies approved 20th May, 1862, "To Secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of

Joseph B. Lynch has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the North-East Quarter of Section Twenty-six in Township Nine North of Range Seventeen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and sixty acres according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

Now Know Ye, That there is, therefore, granted by the United States unto the said Joseph B. Lynch the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Joseph B. Lynch and to his heirs and assigns forever.

letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
