West West quarter of Section Eighteen in Township Nine North of Range Seventeen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and fifty eight acres and seventy two hundredths of an acre

according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Henry Certly the tract of land above described, to have and to hold the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Henry Certly and to his heirs and assigns forever.
