 Whereas, In pursuance of the act of Congress approved
 July 2, 1862, entitled, "An act donating Public Lands to
 the several States and Territories which may provide
 Colleges for the benefit of Agriculture and the Me-
 chanics Arts" there has been deposited in the General
 Land Office Scrip No. 1193, for one quarter section of
 Land, in favor of the State of Alabama, duly assigned
 by the proper authority of the said State to Ephraim
 Oliver for the heirs of Sarah Oliver, deceased, with
 evidence that the same has been located upon the
 West half of the North West quarter, and the West half
 of the South West quarter of Section Two, in Township
 Nine North, of Range Thirteen West, in the district
 of lands subject to sale at Grand Island, Nebras-
 ka, containing one hundred and sixty acres, ac-
 cording to the Official Plat of the Survey of the
 said Land returned to the General Land Office by
 the Surveyor General.

Now know ye, That there is therefore granted by
 the United States unto the said heirs of Sarah Oliver
 as assignees as aforesaid and to their heirs the
 tract of land above described; To Have and to Hold
 the said tract of land, with the appurtenances
 thereof, unto the said Heirs of Sarah Oliver as
 assignees as aforesaid and to their heirs and
 assigns forever.
