North half of the North-west Quarter of Section thirty in Township eleven North, Range fourteen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing seventy seven and seventy seven hundredths of an acre.

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Elizabeth Porter the tract of land above described, to have and to hold the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Elizabeth Porter and to her heirs and assigns forever.
