Potter has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the South East quarter of Section Twelve in Township Ten North of Range Seventeen West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing one hundred and sixty acres according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:
