



Certificate No. 1127. The United States of America.

To all to whom these presents shall come, greeting

Whereas, Mary A. Vance of Buffalo County, Nebraska, has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island, Nebraska, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Mary A. Vance, according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled, "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" and the acts supplemental thereto, for the north half of the south east quarter, and the lots numbered eight and nine of Section thirty two, in township nine north of range fifteen west; in the district of lands subject to sale at Grand Island, Nebraska, containing one hundred and fifty nine acres, and nineteen hundredths of an acre, according to the official Plat of the Survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which tract has been purchased by the said Mary A. Vance. Now know ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Mary A. Vance, and to her heirs, the said tract above described; to have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Mary A. Vance and to her heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof I, Rutherford B. Hayes, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed Given under my hand, at the City of Washington, the Twenty first day of July, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy nine, and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and fourth.
