 has deposited in the General Land Office of the United
 States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office
 at Grand Island Missouri whereby it appears that
 full payment has been made by the said Nancy P
 Viell according to the provisions of the act of Congress
 of the 24th of April 1820 entitled An Act making further
 provision for the sale of the Public Lands and the acts
 supplemental thereto for the lots numbered five six
 and Ten of section ten in Township eight north
 of range seventeen west of the sixth Commercial Meridian
 in Missouri containing one hundred and twenty acres
 and fifty hundredths of an acre according
 to the official Plat of the survey of the said lands
 returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor
 General which said tract has been purchased by the
 said Nancy P Viell

 in consideration of the promises and in conformity
 with the several acts of Congress in such case made
 and provided have given and granted and by these
 presents do give and grant unto the said Nancy
 P Viell and to her heirs the said Tract above
 described To have and to hold the same together
 with all the rights privileges immunities and
 appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging
 unto the said Nancy P Viell and to her heirs and
 assigns forever In Testimony whereof @ Chester A
 Arthur President - of the United States of America has
 caused these letters to be made Patent - and the seal
 of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed
 Given under my hand at the City of Washington
 the sixth day of October in the year of our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred and Eighty one and of
 the Independence of the United States the One hundred
 and sixth By the President - Chester A Arthur
