Greeting:

Homestead Certificate No. 425.

Application 2369. } Whereas There has been deposited in
the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the
Register of the Land Office at Grand Island, Nebraska, whereby it
appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May,
1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the Public Domain
and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Isaac Webb has
been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law,
for the South East quarter of Section Twenty four, in Township
Nine North, of Range Sixteen West, in the District of Lands sub-
ject to sale at Grand Island, Nebraska, containing one hundred
and sixty acres according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the
said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor
General: Now know ye, that there is, therefore, granted by the
United States unto the said Isaac Webb the tract of Land abo-
ve described: To have and to hold the said tract of Land, with
the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Isaac Webb and to his
heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, Ulysses S. Grant, President of the
United States of America, have caused these letters to be made
Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto
affixed.

ton, the Thirtieth day of September, in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sev-
enty four, and of the Independence of the Uni-
ted States the ninety ninth
