Register of the same office at General Land Office Nebraska
whereby it appears that full payment has been made
by the said Charles L Webster according to the
provisions of the act of Congress of the 21st of April
1820 entitled "An Act making further provision for
the sale of the Public Lands" and the acts supplemental
thereto for the west half of the south east quarter of
section fourteen in Township ten north of Range
sixteen west of the sixth Principal meridian in
Nebraska containing eighty acres according to the
official Plat of the Survey of the said land returned
to the General Land office by the Survey General
which said tract has been purchased by the said
Charles L Webster Now know ye that the United States
of America in consideration of the premises and in
conformity with the several acts of Congress in such
case made and provided have given and granted
and by these presents do give and grant unto the
said Charles L Webster and to his heirs the said
tract above described to have and to hold the
same together with all the rights privileges immunities
and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto
belonging unto the said Charles L Webster and to his
heirs and assigns forever

Patent and the Seal of the General Land Office
to be hereunto affixed Given under my hand at the City
of Washington the twenty fifth day of October in the
Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and Eighty four and of the Independence of the United
States the one hundred and ninth
