Timber Culture Certificate No 46. Application 807.

The United States of America, To all to whom these presents shall come: Greeting: Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Grand Island, Nebraska whereby it appears that pursuant to the acts of Congress approved March 3, 1873, March 13, 1874, and June 14, 1878, "To encourage the growth of Timber on the western prairie" the claim of Martha West has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the North West Quarter of Section Ten in Township Eleven, North of Range Thirtieth west of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska containing One Acre and Sixty Acres according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General. Now know Ye: That there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Martha West the tract of Land above described, To have and to hold the said tract of land with the appurtenances thereto unto the said Martha West and to her heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof I Chester A. Arthur President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington the Tenth day of March in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty Three and of the Independence of the United States the 107th
